1. Organizing Authority  
The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron
2. Rules  
This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the West Florida PHRF Class Rules.
3. Eligibility  
The regatta is open to all WFPHRF boats. Fleets include: Cruiser, Pocket Cruiser, Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker & Multi hull.  
Fleets may be combined to constitute a class. Participants without current WFPHRF certificates will be given a rating and a start time, but will not be eligible for an award.
4. Registration & Fees  
\$15 per boat includes drink ticket and refreshment on Friday evening.
5. Ratings and Class Rules  
Except as noted above, boats sailing must have a valid WFPHRF certificate and have a copy of the certificate available. Rating certificates are available online at [westfloridaphrf.org](http://westfloridaphrf.org).

7. Sailing Instructions  
Sailing Instructions, course and start times will be available at Registration.
8. Course  
Racing will be a single race in Sarasota Bay with a pursuit start.
9. Scoring  
Random leg rating will be used. Boats finishing 60 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored TLE without a hearing.
10. Prizes

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each class and will be presented directly after the race.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Docking
